From 11.00 am: Gather at the Masterton Railway Station.

Or: Buy a day return ticket from Wellington and sit back and enjoy the views. The train from Wellington arrives at 11.15am. Board your tour bus at Masterton Railway Station for the first stop on the trail, and on the way your tour guide will give you background information on each property you visit.

Sprout House – Jeremy Howden will show us round his 19ha organically certified mixed cropping property outside Masterton. He has also run for 15 years “The Sprout House” which grows a range of sprouts of which his Snow peas, mung beans and mixed legumes are fully OFNZ certified

Peak Brewery – Rhys and Claudia Morgan will host us around their Organically certified (OFNZ) farm and small brewery, on the Taratahi Flats near Masterton. They make a delicious range of pale ales to black beers with hints of Britain and Europe.

Mela Juices – Andrew and Sue Wright Andrew will show us round Mela Juices. Mela has been making Juices for seven years, in the last two they have been certified to produce Organic Juices (OFNZ). Andrew is contract bottling for Te Koha Organics in the Hawkes Bay and also local Organic growers. For the coming season he will have a range of apple and pear Biogro & Demeter juices for sale. We will be shown how it's all made.
